wool, aniline dye

### Description

Late Chief-style Blanket; style characteristic of Navajo; horizontal bands of white, black, and purple; purple bands edged in red; stepped triangular motifs in red and purple; "complete" one in the center, and two "halves" at edges; made from four-ply Germantown wool yarn and natural white and aniline dyes; Late Phase Three, Transitional Period
