### Description

Series of 2 squarish collages, representing formal and political cohesion between disparate elements; impetus being generated by artist's discovery of little known hate tracts of L. Frank Baum, author of Wizard of Oz children's books; excerpt of one of his articles, from small South Dakota newspaper, pasted into artwork itself; work also meant to be larger critique of subdivision of Native American lands as indicated through use of maps and broad presentation of stereotypes found through pop culture
