16mm acetate film, rayon cord, thread

Description

a) Round, white and green basket with alternating, silver and gold-colored, braided cords around bottom;
(b) separate, matching, round lid with green decorative bow on top and alternating, silver and gold-colored, braided cords around rim; basket and lid composed of strips of acetate film with green and white leaders, instead of natural material traditionally used in basket making; by this, artist intends to add layers of meaning / social commentary to her fine art baskets; film woven into this basket is "The North American Indian, Part 2: How the West Was Won and Honor Lost" (Contemporary Films/McGraw-Hill. 1970)
